| Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ? | Yes. Preventive care services are covered before you meet your deductible . | This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive care without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . | Are there other deductibles for specific services? | No. | You don't have to meet a deductible for specific services, but see the chart starting on page 2 for other costs for services your plan covers. |
| What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ? | Yes. For network providers \$6350 person / \$12700 family. For out of network providers \$35000 person / \$105000 family. | The out of pocket limit is the most you could pay during a coverage period (usually one year) for your share of the costs of covered services. This limit helps you plan for health care expenses. |
| What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit ? | Premiums , balance billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover. | Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out of pocket limit . |
| Will you pay less if you use a network provider ? | Yes. See www.alliantplans.com or call 1-800-811-4793 for a list of preferred providers . | If you use a network provider or other health care provider , this plan will pay some or all of the costs of covered services. Be aware, your network provider or hospital may use an out of network provider for some services. Plans use the term in- network , preferred, or participating for providers in their network .
